WEEKLY CAMP THEMES

Week 1: American Pride

We will explore what makes our country unique and what the colors red, white, and blue stand for. Patriotic songs will be sung as the campers celebrate our country's birthday.

Week 2: Passport to Fitness

Campers will jump-start their quest toward a fit and healthier self. All will have lots of fun with fitness, sports, team building and physical activities.

Week 3: Mad Science

This week will be filled with crazy experiments. Campers measure solutions, combine ingredients, add colors and invent noisy, smelly and messy concoctions.

Week 4: International Week

With their passport in hand, campers travel the world to discover countries. Campers learn about different cultures and countries through games, music, cooking and crafts. The week ends with a Parade of Nations at the Southern Saratoga YMCA Branch.

Week 5: Art Week

Campers learn and explore all forms of art and create wonderful masterpieces. They will be introduced to the works of famous artists. A representative from Arts and Glass in Clifton Park will be on site to conduct an art class.

Week 6: Water Week

Campers have fun during this week filled with water activities. The campers will learn about the water in and around us including our oceans, lakes and ponds. Water experiments will be conducted to learn about water's three states of matter.

Week 7: Literacy

Campers explore the different genres of literacy such as books, poems and plays. They will become authors by writing and illustrating their own literary work.

Week 8: Cooking and Healthy Eating

Our young chefs will learn how to prep and cook different foods during the week. There will be a concentration on learning how the body needs good nutrition to keep active and healthy. A trip to Stewart's will be scheduled.

Week 9: Nature and Ecology

Nature will be the focus of activities during this week. Campers will take nature walks to discover different animal habitats, trees and insects. Campers will gain an understanding about the importance of keeping our planet safe by recycling and spending energy wisely.

Week 10: Circus Week

Campers will juggle, walk the tight rope, jump through hoops and clown around as they discover the life of the circus. Campers show their talents when they perform under the big top on the last day of camp.
